



Norman County Historic Barn Quilt Trail

Guidelines for Joining the Norman County Historic Barn Quilt Trail

1. The barn quilt must be located in Norman County. Other locations will be considered upon request.
2. The barn quilt must be a separate piece attached to a barn, shed, house, garage, business, post, or similar location.
3. It is suggested the barn quilt be visible from a public road.
4. The barn quilt must be made of durable, high quality materials and paint.
5. The barn quilt must have a family friendly theme or design and must have elements of traditional quilt design.
6. The barn quilt should avoid copyrighted materials.
7. The barn quilt should not contain wording to avoid becoming a sign that is regulated by municipal ordinances.
8. The barn quilt belongs to the owner who is responsible for maintaining its appearance.
9. The Norman County Historic Barn Quilt Trail (NCHBQT) will use photographs of barn quilts and its address on the NCHBQT website and trail guide map.
10. The owner agrees to hold harmless NCHBQT and its committee for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of actions related to the barn quilt and the Norman County Historic Barn Quilt Trail.
